

About Fiber Club*

Fiber Club* was founded in October 2022 by artist and arts administrator Katie Shulman as a response to an expressed need among creative practitioners in southeast Michigan to organize around a shared curiosity and passion for fiber and textile-based processes. Since its founding, the group has seen enthusiastic adoption, notable growth, and encouragement from the greater arts community.

Fiber Club* has a membership of all backgrounds, ages, affiliations, and identities who gather monthly to share opportunities and resources, view and discuss each other's work, connect, and build community. Membership is contingent solely upon a desire to participate in the Fiber Club* community. Active participants currently include over 100 fiber artists. Anyone is invited to participate.

About Mending the Net

Fiber Club*'s first group show follows the ethos of inclusion. Not only did all our members have the opportunity to participate in the show, but by positioning the exhibition as part of Detroit Month of Design, we are inviting the city to learn about Fiber Club*, creating a new access point for the wider community to engage with a diverse array of creative practices and to learn more about art and design that is grounded in fiber and textile-based art forms both traditional and contemporary.

Mending the Net features the work of a diverse cross-section of fiber artists in the Detroit metro area, offering the community an opportunity to experience a varied range of textile-based art in one thematically-linked show.

About The Convent

The Convent Detroit is a recently renovated art and wellness hub in a former convent. Built in 1929, the Convent was originally home to the nuns of the Sisters of the Holy Family of Nazareth, and has since served various types of live/work communities including a nursing home and a detox facility. Recently purchased by the owner of Detroit's famous "The Schvitz," the building now houses studios for artists and wellness practitioners as well as meeting and event space.
